Members of the wider-school-community from Eurovision countries will be invited speak with the students about their lived experiences.  Older pupils will complete filmmaking workshops with MakoEducation to film each class performing their song. With the final performance being filmed and sent out to parents post edit.
East Prescot Road Nursery School	Eurovision arts project	A 4 week Eurovision Arts project with workshops by a visual artist (printmaker) and a filmmaker. Producing a large-scale Eurovision/Ukrainian mural and filmed a Eurovision style concert. Film to share with parents, media and stakeholders.
Gateacre School / Secondary and Sixth form	Culture event	Cross curriculum Ukrainian themes lessons around culture. Each room across the school will be filled with music, food, dance, information and decorations, celebrating the Form's chosen Country and all students will experience an immersive sense of the country.  Some aspects of the arts & crafts and storytelling may also be based in our BIG Little Library, in Belle Vale Shopping Centre. Any workshops held there would be available for the local community and primary schools to access as well.  The school kitchen also plans on creating a celebratory menu for the week of the Final, choosing a chosen Country each day of the final week.
